A complex system of licenses stands at the heart of this structure, providing the framework within which entities ranging from sprawling utility providers to pioneering renewable.

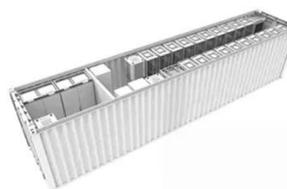
