Overview

A group of Chinese firms is partnering with YLB, Bolivia's state-owned lithium mining company, to build a \$1 billion project to exploit the country's large—and mostly untapped—lithium resources. The worldwide transition to electric vehicles and renewable energy storage has created unprecedented demand for battery-grade lithium carbonate, fundamentally altering resource extraction dynamics across South America's lithium-rich corridor. In 2021, YLB started soliciting proposals to mine Bolivia's lithium using direct lithium extraction.
