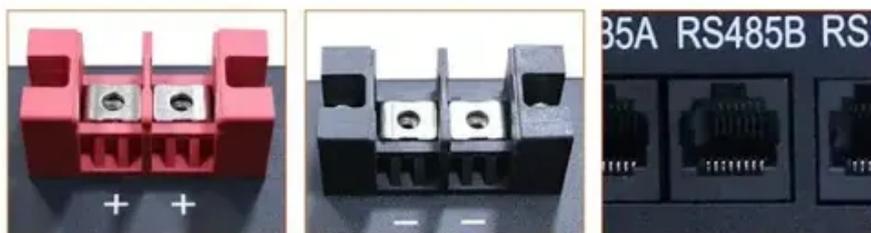




Can I use water to flush photovoltaic panels on sunny days

Can I just spray my solar panels with water to clean them?

The short answer is: yes — but only if you do it the right way. Done wrong, spraying water can actually reduce efficiency or even damage your panels over time. Let's break it down in plain language. Use non-abrasive sponges, microfiber cloths, or soft. Water that comes straight from the faucet or hose is considered “hard water” and contains minerals that can leave deposits, water spots, and scaling on your solar panels. Finally, rinse thoroughly with a hose using a gentle spray and allow them to dry. Wait to wash them when they've cooled down or use warm water instead.

In general, a mixture of water and mild detergent (like dish soap) works well, though you can also use 1 part vinegar and 8 parts water or a solar panel cleaning solution.
