Overview

A 2022 University of California study found lead concentrations 12x higher than EPA limits in water collected from older solar arrays. Yikes! It's like your panels are mixing a techy version of Long Island Iced Tea - but you definitely don't want to drink this cocktail. That "free" rainwater looks tempting, especially during droughts. But here's the million-dollar question - is photovoltaic panel runoff actually safe to drink?

Let's filter. Unlike coal or nuclear plants that consume millions of gallons daily for cooling, solar panels typically use only a fraction of that water annually for maintenance. Despite what it says on the dodgy parts of the internet I think panels are just as safe as metal tanks which are lined with plastic (the corrugated Lysaght material is called aquaplate) or poly tanks for that matter. Manufacturing processes, material composition, and end-of-life disposal raise legitimate concerns about whether solar panels. Solar power is without question one of the leading green energy sources as the world moves increasingly away from fossil fuels. Solar has justifiably been greeted as truly sustainable, clean, and increasingly efficient and cost effective. However, even solar energy can't claim to have 100%.

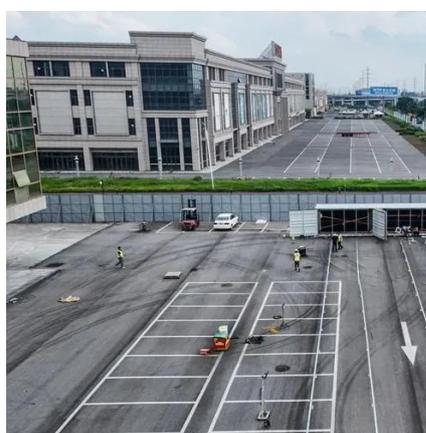


Do Solar Panels Contaminate Drinking Water?



