




Electric vehicle adoption Ijubljana





Overview

Slovenia's capital Ljubljana will add 16 new battery-electric buses to its public transport network under a €11.6 million project co-funded by the European Union, as the city pushes ahead with efforts to cut emissions and modernise its fleet. Hop on the electric Urban train for a relaxed tour of the city's sights, or take advantage of the Kavalir electric vehicles, which provide free rides for the elderly and people with mobility. On 8 August 2025, Slovenia published a new public call (JP SUB-EV25-1) in the Uradni list SR, allocating non-repayable financial incentives to promote electric mobility. The initiative targets acceleration of clean vehicle uptake—aimed at businesses, private entrepreneurs, and VAT-registered. The city of Ljubljana, capital of Slovenia, will expand its electric bus fleet with the purchase of 16 new battery-electric vehicles as part of a project co-financed by the European Union. Organized jointly by UL, GEN-I, and Elektro. The Ministry of Cohesion and Regional Development has approved EU funding for the project Integrated Territorial Investments City of Ljubljana e-buses. 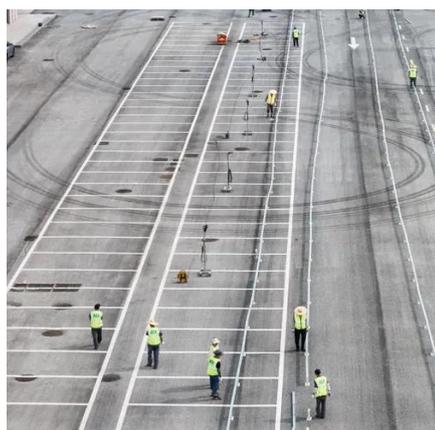
