



Electric vehicle incentives addis ababa





Overview

Key Policies: A 2024 ban on importing petrol and diesel cars, tax breaks for EVs, and incentives for local manufacturing are reshaping the market. **Renewable Energy:** Hydropower projects like the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam are lowering electricity costs, making EVs more. **Price Range:** EVs cost \$18,000–\$100,000, with models like the BYD Seagull starting at \$19,000. **Top Brands:** BYD, Toyota, GAC, and Tesla offer options from budget to luxury. **Charging Infrastructure:** Ethiopia has 25 public charging stations, with home charging being the most reliable. It is one of several African countries to be introducing incentives to encourage EV uptake as a means. In a notable policy shift, the Ethiopian government has increased customs duty on imported electric domestic vehicles, raising the rate from 15 percent to 20 percent. The decision to implement a 5 percent increase follows the International Monetary Fund's (IMF) call for Ethiopia to expand its tax. Imports of vehicles with combustion engines have 15% VAT; up to 100% excise tax; 10% surtax; and 3% withholding tax—thus making them extremely expensive in the local market.
