



Has the cost of wind power generation dropped significantly





Overview

Like a steady breeze powering progress, wind energy costs keep falling to new lows. You'll find today's wind power is 70% cheaper than it was in 2010, thanks to bigger turbines and smarter designs. In 2010, the cost of new capacity additions stood at \$2,272 per 1 kilowatt (kW); in 2023 it was \$1,160 per 1 kW, International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) reports. Department of Energy today released three reports showing record growth in land-based wind energy, significant expansion of the pipeline for offshore wind projects, and continued decline in the cost of wind energy generation. The trends of the year indicate a faster. The levelised cost of electricity produced from most forms of renewable power continued to fall year-on-year in 2023, with solar PV leading the cost reductions, followed by offshore wind.



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Wind power costs continue to decline


Levelized cost of electricity (LCOE) generated by onshore wind parks dropped to less than one third over the same period, from \$0.111 to \$0.033 per 1 kilowatt-hour (deflated).

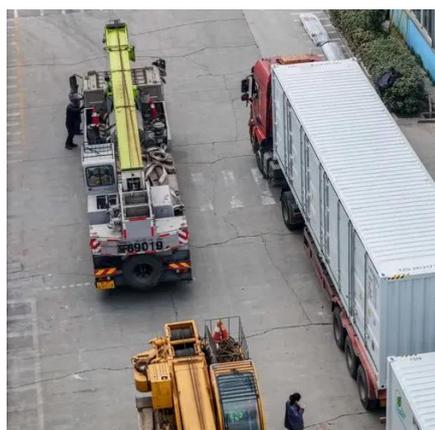

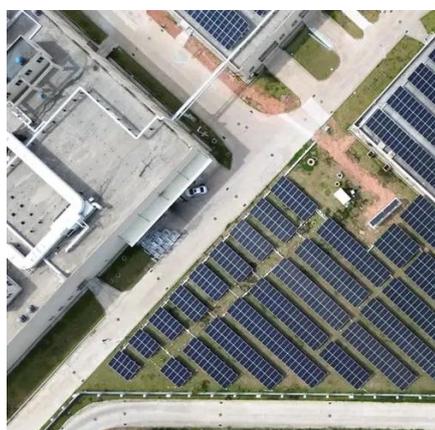


Falling Costs Make Wind, Solar More

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Renewable Power Generation Costs in 2023
