



How does hydro-wind-geothermal generate electricity





Overview

Solar power harnesses the sun's energy, wind energy utilizes wind turbines, hydroelectric power relies on flowing water, and geothermal energy taps into the Earth's heat. By investing in renewable energy, we can contribute to a more sustainable and clean energy future. The United States leads the world in geothermal electricity-generating capacity —just over 4 gigawatts. To generate power from geothermal systems, three elements are needed: Heat —Abundant heat found in rocks deep underground, varying by depth, geology, and geographic location. As of 2017, wind turbines, like the Braes of Doune wind farm near Stirling, Scotland, are now producing 539,000 megawatts of power around the world—22 times more than 16. The steam is used to drive a turbine, which generates electricity.

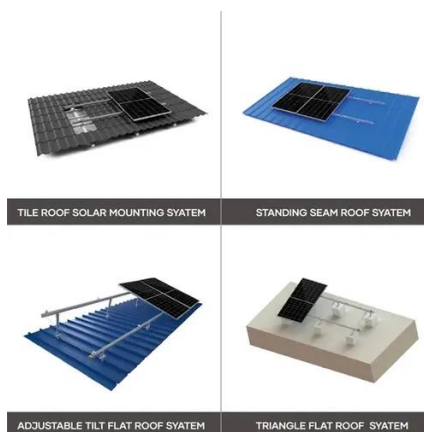
How does geothermal energy work to produce electricity?
