Overview





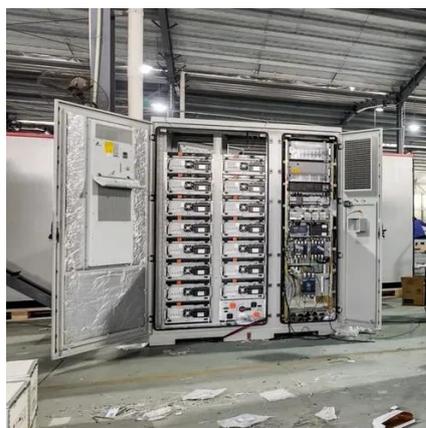
