Overview

5 (Risk Management) of Supplement 5 of the German DIN EN 62305-3 standard describes that a lightning protection system designed for class of LPS III (LPL III) meets the usual requirements for PV systems. Lightning protection can be described by considering the three aims of lightning protection: To reduce the probable risk of damage due to a direct lightning strike. To control the magnitude of galvanic coupling and induced surges. To deliver an effective discharge path into the ground. As a general rule, rooftop photovoltaic systems must not interfere with the existing lightning protection on the basis of the risk analysis and protection costs. Table 10 presents the recommended standards related to PV systems including PV. The NEC (National Electrical Codebook) requires that all exposed metal surfaces be grounded regardless of system voltage. 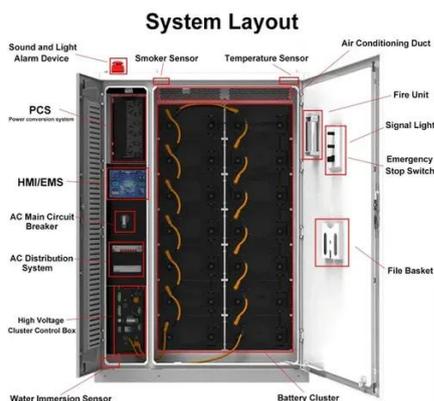


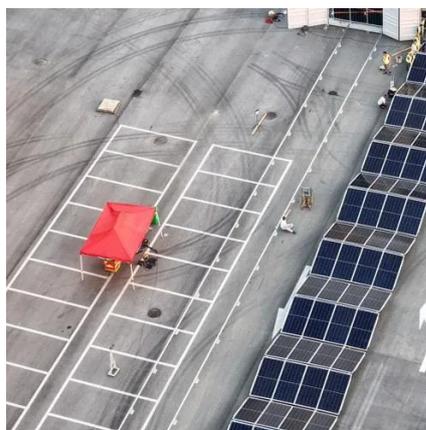
