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Generally speaking, the answer is NO, a homeowners association is not able to prevent you from installed solar panels, and that is solidly in law in Florida Statute 163. Solar panels require direct access to sunlight to generate energy -- but what can you do to prevent the possibility that your neighbor will add a second story or plant a large tree?

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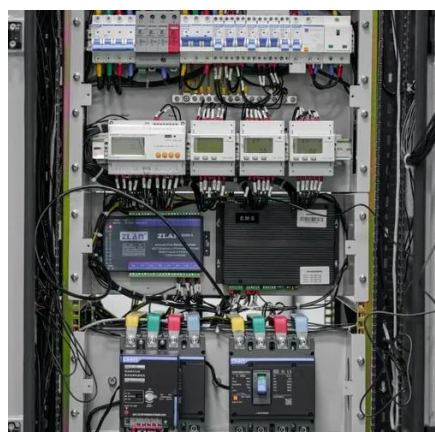

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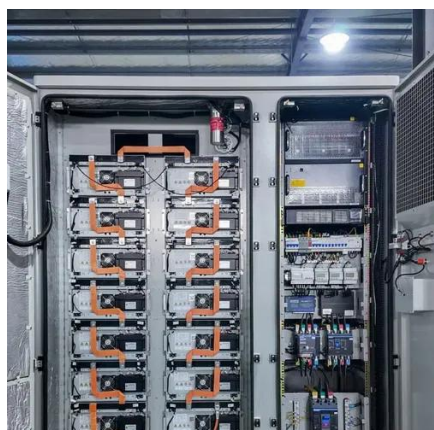


## Neighbor complaining of blinding glare from my solar panels
